**Kingdom (NY, Club Vortex, Lower End Spasm) comes to Bouncement at Lava**

**Kingdom** (Club Vortex, Lower End Spasm) is a Brooklyn-based producer, DJ, and digital artist whose DJ sets and live performances have been gathering a rabid following over the past year. His mixes and productions blend Latin, Kwaito, Bmore, House, Juke, Bassline, Bubbling, Dubstep, and Dancehall influences and have garnered a ton of buzz and remix credits. He'll come through **Chicago** on **May 15th** and bring his signature style to a set at **Bouncement**, a regular night at **Lava**. Bouncement is piloted by a master of mashed-up genre fusion, **DJ C** and with the help of Chicago's resident expert in all things Grime, UK Garage, and Bassline **Whoa-B**, the night will showcase the best in the bass-heavy, dance-savvy tropical sounds from around the world.

**Kingdom** is a producer to watch. his track "You Don't Know Michelle" was recently played on Annie Mac's show on BBC radio, as well as receiving a great deal of praise including being posted on Floukids and Palms Out Sounds. He was recently featured in several articles on the Fader magazine blog and his newest Exclusive March 2009 Mix for Lower End Spasm has been picked up by many blogs, including Discobelle, Dutty Artz and Trash Menagerie. In 2008 Kingdom hosted mixtape release parties in NY, LA, and London, and debuted his new party Club Vortex at Glasslands (NYC). The latest volume in his mixtape series also caught the attention of independent digital music label RCRD LBL, which carries an original track and two recent remixes. Kingdom holds residencies at Happy Ending (NYC), Mr. Black (NYC) and Milky Way (Boston) in addition to frequent sets at Night Slugs (London) and Mustache (Los Angeles).

Beat producer, party scientist, and remixer of artists from M.I.A. to Gregory Isaacs, **DJ C** (Mashit, Soul Jazz, XL, Modular) continues to spread his fiercely eclectic gospel of bass-heavy, bounced-up dancefloor-blends across the land. He's been pumping out a series of records on labels including a remix of M.I.A.'s U.R.A.Q.T. on XL Recordings, as well as singles/remixes for Ninja Tune, Soul Jazz, Modular, Tigerbeat6, and his own Mashit imprint; sharing the releases with the likes of Sinden, Drop The Lime, Ghislain Poirier, The Bug, Kid606, Warrior Queen and many more. Since then his tunes and DJ sets have continued to evolve into ever-more devastating dance-floor monsters.

**MC Zulu** (Staubgold, Mashit, Ninjatune) is a producer, engineer and an established solo artist as well as collaborator with DJ C, Kool Keith, Ghislain Poirier, Aceyalone and more. Zulu got his start as a producer of house and underground hip hop here in Chicago but his Panamanian/Jamaican roots have brought him back to reggae. Zulu's international combinations, his timeless-yet-futuristic melodic sensibilities, his experience in all genres of dance music, and his raw talent make him one of the brightest up-and-comers on the reggae scene today.

**Whoa-B** (Brüt Force Family, SixPoint Chicago, Dented Sessions) is a Chicago-based DJ who specializes in electronic music of British origin, namely dubstep and grime. A member of the Brüt Force Family, he has long been an advocate of all things UK garage. In addition to having played local venues such as Cafe Lura, Lava Lounge, Sonotheque, and Smartbar, he has headlined dubstep events in Dallas and Boston. He has become known for a series of YouTube videos including the somewhat-viral Dubstep Quickmix.
